1. The purported referral of the complaints against the first respondent by the Competition Commission to the Competition Tribunal on or about 20 December 2007 under sections 4(1)(b)(ii), 5(1), 5(2) and 9(1) of the Competition Act 89 of 1998 (which complaints collectively make up the "first separated complaint" as referred to in the Order of the Competition Tribunal dated 13 May 2010) is set aside on the grounds that the Tribunal has no jurisdiction.
